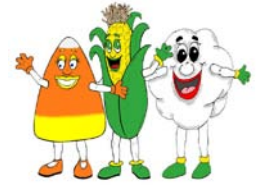
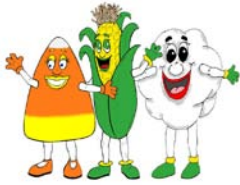

WAIVER OF LIABILITY

This form must be signed by each person participating

I realize that the North Ridgeville Corn Festival Bed Race requires physical conditioning and I represent that I am in sound medical condition. I have no physical or medical condition that would endanger either myself or others.

I accept responsibility for the condition of my/our "bed" and agree to abide by all rules of the race. I understand that the race can be a hazardous activity that has many dangers and risks including injury resulting from accident or physical exertion. I understand that racing involves a risk of injury. I agree, as a consideration of and in consideration for being permitted to participate in the race, to freely and expressly assume and accept any and all risks of injury to the rider, any pusher, or any property loss or damage.

I agree to release the sponsors and promoters of the race including the North Ridgeville Corn Festival, Inc and their respective agents, directors, officers, and employees from any and all responsibility or liability for injuries or damages which result, either directly, or otherwise, from my participation in the race. I agree not to make a claim against or bring suit against the North Ridgeville Corn Festival, Inc Committee or other sponsors or affiliated organizations for injuries or damages relating to racing and/or other activities during the race.

I am aware that this is a release of liability and a contract between those signed below and the North Ridgeville Corn Festival, Inc. I am signing it freely and of my own accord, and I recognize and agree that it is binding upon myself, my heirs and assigns.

NORTH RIDGEVILLE CORN FESTIVAL 2009 BED RACES

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Entry fee is \$25 per team for applications postmarked by July 18, 2009 or \$35 for on-site registration at 10 a.m. on August 8, 2009.
2. All participants must be at least 16 years of age. Each participant must provide a signed waiver. Each participant under the age of 18 must provide a waiver signed by a parent and notarized, or may provide a waiver on site to be signed by the parent in front of a North Ridgeville Corn Festival Committee member (identification of both parent and participant must be provided or the participant will not be allowed to race).
3. Each team will consist of 5 members (one rider and four pushers).
4. Teams and beds must be checked in no later than 10 a.m. on race day.
5. Bed must be decorated for the theme – 35th Corn Festival Anniversary.
6. Each team must provide its own bed for the races. Bed must be twin size or larger (no youth beds, toddler beds or cribs, etc.). Bed must be on wheels. Bed may be altered but no decorations or alterations may extend beyond the width of the bed. No propulsion system or motor or mechanism may be used to power the bed.
7. One member must sit or recline on the bed during the race at all times. If the rider comes off the bed, the bed must stop until the rider is back on the bed, seated or reclining. The four other team members will push the bed during the race (no pulling is allowed). Bed must remain in contact with the pavement at all times during the race. Any bed not passing inspection prior to the race may be disqualified (it if cannot be repaired prior to race time at 10:30 a.m.).
8. Participants should be aware of safety. It is suggested that participants wear appropriate shoes, clothing and gear.
9. Races will be run in heats and the top two teams in each division will be in the final race in each division. Number of heats will be determined by the number of entries. Judges reserve the right to move an entry from one division into another, if necessary.
10. Decision of the judges is final.
